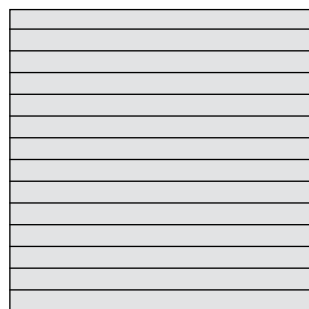
Manufacturing Styles

Solid wood tabletops can be manufactured in several different ways. Our premium wood tables are constructed of **planks** running the full length—the longest dimension—of the table, typically with random widths up to 3 1/2."

We also offer a **butcher-block** style with planks of even widths, typically 1", 1 3/4", or a custom size.

Cleats

Tabletops larger than 32" are made with flattener cleats that are screwed to the underside of the top to add support and impede warping. The cleats are intended to show.



Other Options

- **Thickness:** 1 1/2", 1 3/4", and 2" standard; others available
- **Radius corners:** Two for wall-positioned or wall-mounted tabletops, four for freestanding tabletops; 3" radius is standard
- **Corner cuts:** Any size
- **Stain:** Standard and custom colors available

Live-Edge Tables

A live-edge table's size and shape is determined by the tree from which it is made; each piece is unique because of natural edges and wood grain.

One way to make a live-edge table is to use a single wood slab without any joining. The width of the table, however, is limited to the size of the tree. When a wider table is needed, two pieces of wood from the same tree may be joined.

When joining pieces of wood or holding a crack together, a butterfly joint must be used. This can be made of the same species as the slab but is often made of a different species and used as an accent. Resin, either colored or clear, is used to fill deep cracks and knots. (Because of natural variation, certain joining techniques may not work for all slabs of wood.)



Diagonal Joining

Drop-Leaf Tables

These tables are available in solid wood, laminate, and padded versions. Slide-bar drop-leaf mechanisms are made from heavy-duty zinc-plated solid steel and allow for a completely sag-free extension of your table. Each mechanism consists of one slide-bar and two hinges per leaf, allowing for maximum support. Heavy-duty hardware locks the leaves in the closed position.

The hardware is unobtrusive, and the springless hinges allow for safe operation—no pinched fingers! A five-year warranty is included on the hardware.

Metal Fabrication and Powder Coating

We have a fully stocked metal shop that can custom-fabricate and powder coat almost anything.

Powder coating is different than conventional paint because it does not require a solvent to keep the binder/filler parts in suspension.

It is applied by an electrostatic process and then cured to create a stronger bond and more durable finish than paint.

Table Heights

The height of furniture can greatly affect the feel of your establishment. What atmosphere do you want? Are there any regulations that you need to be aware of? Are there any architectural features of your space that may help determine the size of your furniture (lower ceiling, etc.)? Once you answer those questions, choosing the size of your furniture should be easy.



Standard Height. (28"–30" table height; 18"–19" seat height)
This is the most common table height in restaurants. Most people find this height very comfortable, and it is the only height that complies with ADA regulations.

Counter Height. (34"–36" table height; 26" seat height)
This height has a more casual feel and makes it easier for people who are sitting to talk with people who are standing. Counter-height tables work well in small areas because they give the illusion of taking up less space.

Bar Height. (40"–42" table height; 30" seat height)
This taller, thinner height is good for small spaces and bar areas. The difference between standing and sitting at this table height is minimal, creating a casual atmosphere that is conducive to socializing.

Seating Capacity

The architectural standard for dining suggests an allowance of 300 square inches per diner. However, different establishments have different needs. Some can get by with less space per diner, but others may require more table space for larger food items, special utensils, and condiments.

Wood tabletops are subject to shrinkage, warping, and seasonal cracks due to the natural moisture within. These occurrences are nonstructural and will not affect the durability of the table; therefore, we do not warranty against natural cracking or gapping, as these are not defects in manufacturing or craftsmanship. Depending on time of year and where the table is shipping, we may advise delaying your shipment due to extreme temperature changes during transit.

We recommend using solid wood tabletops in cool room settings (68–72 degrees Fahrenheit) with a relative humidity between 40% and 45%. Proper air circulation in the room is necessary. Any sudden changes in temperature or humidity can affect the tabletop, so change your thermostat settings gradually as the seasons change. This also applies to the storage of wood tabletops. If you plan to store your wood tabletops for an extended period of time in a storage facility, make certain that you do so in a climate-controlled unit.

Excessive heat, cold, dryness, or humidity are often the culprits for any wood cracking or splitting. Carefully consider the placement of your tables. Avoid direct sunlight, heat sources, and bright lighting. Also, do not place tables within close proximity to radiators, heating vents, space heaters, ovens, or wood-burning stoves.

Everyday care of wood tabletops requires attention. Do not use vinyl table cloths and/or glass tops on your tables in order to prevent warping. Avoid placing extremely hot plates directly on the wood tabletops so as to avoid staining or cracking from these high temperatures. Wipe up any excessive water immediately. Never use polish or cleaners that contain alcohol, silicone, or ammonia. The lifetime of solid wood tables may be extended by sanding and restaining in the future if proper care is given to the tables.
